

Resembles a husky - just smaller

General Size Comparisons

Alaskan Malamute:
23-25" at the shoulder
75-85 pounds

Siberian Husky:
20-23 1/2" at the shoulder
35-60 pounds

Alaskan Klee Kai:
usually under 17" at the shoulder
usually under 25 pounds-unless overweight

Wedge-shaped Head
often has facial markings

Prick Ears

Curled Tail
may hang down if relaxed
or in unfamiliar situations

Temperament

very curious, active, quick & agile; may be territorial despite their size; affectionate with family members but is reserved and cautious with strangers and in unfamiliar situations

Eyes

can be shades of blue, brown, amber, one of each, or multi-colored within an eye

Coat Colors

can be shades of Grey and White, Black and White, Red and White and Solid White

If you think you may have an AKK, please contact AKKNR. We will have a volunteer come to verify the dog is an AKK and begin the rescue process.
